The Adult Education Programs are based on the belief that every adult, regardless of age, is entitled to a basic education. The following programs are available to give adults a second chance to further their education: Adult Basic Education GED Testing English as a Second Language Literacy GED Classes United States Citizenship GED Official Practice Tests (OPT) The Adult Education Programs are open to anyone who is 17 or older. There is no cost for instruction and/or materials for students enrolled in Adult Education classes. The Adult Education Programs are sponsored by the Abilene Independent School District and are supported by state and federal funds. How do I register for GED classes? Call (325) 671-4419 to sign up for a two day orientation. Attendance is required on both days to complete the registration process. For other classes, call (325) 671-4419 for registration dates.

Christian Women's Job Corps of Abilene

This is free, faith-based, 13-week program. All classes are centered around Biblical principles. Classes include Time Management, Money Management, Relationships and Keyboarding, Word, Excel, and Internet Usage. They also have group counseling once a week at a local university. The program cannot accept a sex offender and it is a case-by-case decision on someone convicted of physical violence.
