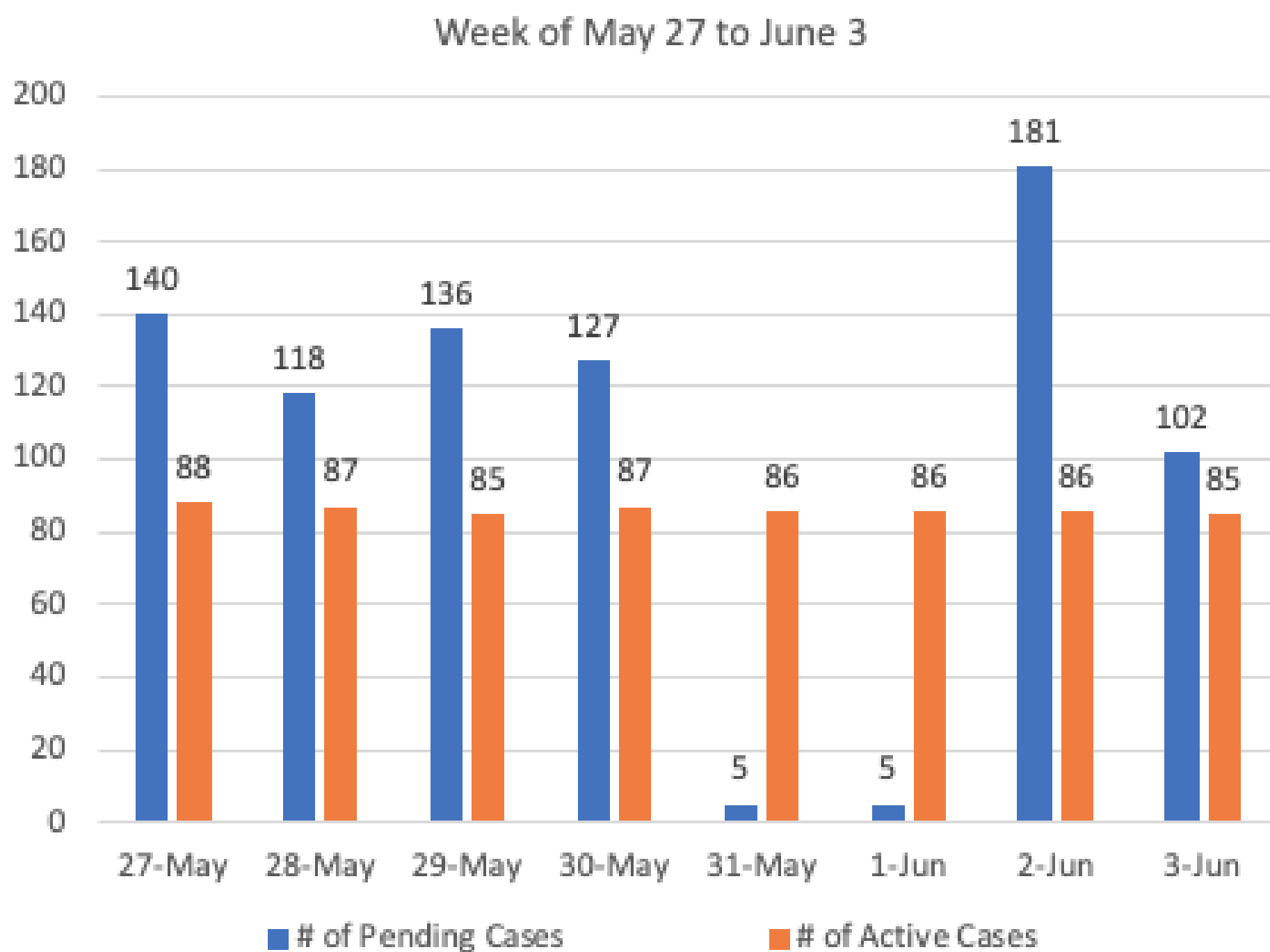


BEXAR COUNTY JAIL COVID-19 UPDATE

The Texas Criminal Justice Coalition, in partnership with SA Stands, is producing weekly updates on the impact of COVID-19 within the Bexar County Jail. Data is sourced from the Texas Commission on Jail Standards and the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District.

COVID-19 NUMBERS AS OF JUNE 3, 2020

The chart below, compiled from data reported by the Texas Commission on Jail Standards, represents the daily totals of active, confirmed cases of COVID-19, and the number of pending test results among those incarcerated.



Incarcerated Population

85 individuals with active, positive test confirmations

102 individuals with pending test results

788 individuals in quarantine/isolated (non-active cases)

1 individual being treated offsite for an active case

1 confirmed death related to COVID-19

Jail Staff

16 individuals with active, positive-test confirmations

82 individuals in quarantine/isolated, pending test results

As reported by the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District, there have been **403** incarcerated individuals and **59** jail staff who have tested positive for COVID-19 from the beginning of the outbreak to June 3, 2020. Out of the total number of cases, **79% of incarcerated individuals and 24% of staff members showed no symptoms.**
